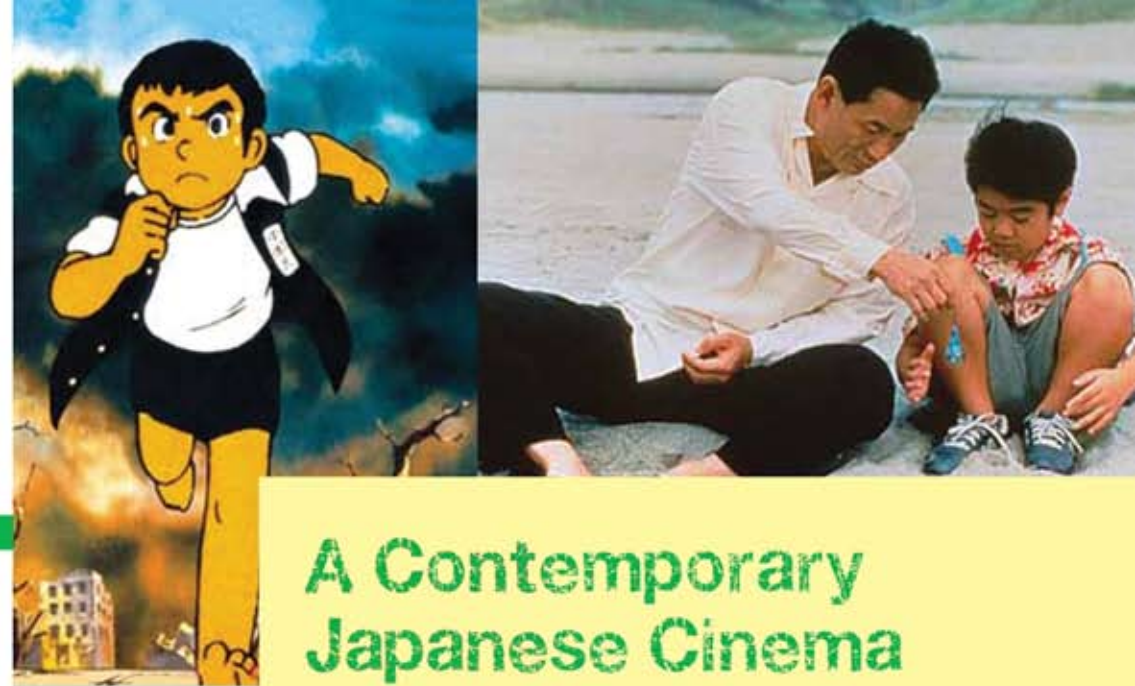
TICKETS
